Home Office Phones

- ◆ Two Lines (one personal / one business)
- ◆ Distinctive Ring (fax on home line)
- ◆ Cheap Long Distance (4.9 cents/minute)
- ◆ Calling Card (8 cents/minute)
- ◆ 800 Number (tied to business Line)
- ◆ Voice Mail (both lines)
- ◆ Custom Choice on both?
- ◆ Phone Company Phone? (shows messages)

Office Computer Setup

- ❖ Laptop is Essential
- ❖ I have a Desktop and a Laptop
- ❖ If you have both, Networking is essential
- ❖ Windows 98 2nd Edition or ME
 - ✍ Allows Internet Connection Sharing

Choosing an Internet Provider

- ◆ Nation-wide Local Dial-up
- ◆ 800 Dial-up Comes in Handy
- ◆ I Use Earthlink, MSN will work. AOL will work, but I don't recommend.
- ◆ High Speed
 - ✍ Cable, DSL, Wireless, Satellite

Internet Connection Sharing

- ◆ Connect Desktop to Dial-up Internet
- ◆ Install Internet Connection Sharing (Windows Setup)
- ◆ Connect Other Computers to Hub or Directly to main Computer
- ◆ All Computers have access once the main computer is connected

High Speed

- ◆ High Speed Connection into Office
- ◆ Need a DSL Hub / Also works as Network Hub
- ◆ Route High Speed to Hub and then Connect each Computer to Hub
- ◆ Now all computers have high speed access
- ◆ Cost for Hub: \$99-\$199

Emails

- ◆ Today there's no reason not to have your own domain name and email
- ◆ You'll never have to change your email address again
- ◆ It also looks more professional

- ◆ Option: \$32 for Domain for 2 years
\$35 setup and \$5/month paid annually

Register a Domain Name

- ◆ Pick something that people can associate with your company
- ◆ Pick something easy to remember
- ◆ BuyDomains.com (\$16/year) & Others
- ◆ Main choices .com .net .org
- ◆ New choices .info .biz .cc .ws
- ◆ If name is taken, try adding a dash

Domain Examples

- ◆ Buildingscience.com
- ◆ Natresnet.org
- ◆ Erha.com
- ◆ Buildersintegritygroup.com
- ◆ Environmentalbldgprod.com
- ◆ Eacctsys.com

Get Your Email Setup

- ◆ Setup email addresses for all your staff
- ◆ Setup a general email address for your web site (e.g. info@yourdomain.com)
- ◆ Make sure your email address is on your business card and all other information you give out
- ◆ I use Outlook Express because of ease of use and multiple accounts

- ◆ Local Dial-Up Numbers at Destination(s)

Equipment Checklist

- ❖ Laptop & Power Cord
- ❖ Mouse & Mouse Pad
- ❖ Regular 6ft-10ft Phone Cord
- ❖ 25ft Phone Extension Cord
- ❖ Phone Line Splitter
- ❖ Phone Line Coupler
- ❖ Ethernet Cord & Connector

Software Checklist

- ❖ Microsoft Office or Other
- ❖ Outlook or Other Schedule/Contacts
- ❖ Outlook Express or Email Software
- ❖ Work Related Software
FrontPage, WS_ftp, PaintShop Pro, Acrobat, Quicken?

Personal Files Checklist

- ◆ Outlook Express Address Book
c:/windows/application data/microsoft/address book/
- ◆ Outlook Schedule / Contacts
c:/windows/application data/microsoft/outlook/ or
c:/windows/local settings/application data/microsoft/outlook/
outlook.pst
- ◆ Favorites
c:/windows/favorites/
- ◆ Work Files
c:/my documents/?

Before You Go

- ◆ Make Sure You Have Your Equipment
- ◆ Make Sure All the Right Software is Installed and Working
- ◆ Transfer Your Personal/Work Files
- ◆ Search and Print Local Connection Numbers for Your Destination

Dial-Up Networking Setup

- ◆ Go To My Computer / Dial-Up Networking
- ◆ Create Dial-up Networking for Travel, 800, Common Places
- ◆ Setup Dial Properties
 - ✍ Local / Travel / Dial-9 / Credit Card
- ◆ Copy Icons to Desktop

Outlook Express Setup

- ◆ Setup Account the Same as Desktop
- ◆ Go to Advanced Setting and Change to Leave a Copy of Mail on Server set for number of days you'll be gone
- ◆ This allows to get your messages on your desktop once you get home

Using Laptop Offline

- ◆ Learn to work offline.
- ◆ You can write emails without being online.
- ◆ You can review web sites offline if you pre-surf them.

Connecting at the Airport

- ◆ Find Pay Phone with Data Jack
- ◆ Turn on Computer
- ◆ Plug Modem into Jack
- ◆ Check for Instructions on Pay Phone
- ◆ Dial 800 or Deposit Coins and Dial Local or Dial Credit Card

Connecting at Your Hotel

- ◆ Local Calls Cost? Is there a time limit?
- ◆ Does Phone have Data Port?
- ◆ Does Hotel Provide a Desk or Table with a plug-in?
- ◆ How Far away is the Phone?
- ◆ Connect to Data Port or use Phone Line Splitter to Connect Phone and Modem
- ◆ Check phone for Dialing Instructions as in Dial 9

Connecting at Your Hotel

- ❖ Open Dial-up Networking to Change Properties of Travel Setup
- ❖ Change Phone Number to Local Number
- ❖ Return to Desktop and Double-Click on Travel Icon
- ❖ Select Dial 9 if Necessary and Change Area Code
- ❖ Click Connect and Listen for Familiar Connection Sounds
- ❖ If No sound, check Dial 9 or area code issues
