Qualified Contractors

Kansas Building Science Institute (KBSI) has trained numerous Home Energy Raters who work in the KC Market, who are also Home Performance Contractors

The Energy and Environmental Ratings Alliance has certified a group of KC raters who have formed their own association called KCHERO

Several existing energy conscious contractors have joined with us

BPI Testing and Certification

KBSI has become a BPI affiliate organization

- Has qualified BPI proctors
- Is working with WX programs in surrounding states to certify to BPI standards
- Has an on-going history of HERS, HVAC and HP Contractor training programs

Local Consumer Awareness

- KCHERO has been working to stimulate local home performance awareness
- The KCHBA has established a Build Green program which includes Energy Star certification Home Show third week of March – Steve Thomas
- Local utilities have formed an association called the Heartland Utilities for Energy Efficiency (HUEE) and have established a voluntary Public Benefits Fund Grant awarded to M.E.C. for public awareness
