Goals


- Develop a certification path for raters seeking to expand their knowledge base

RESNET Proposed Rater Certification Path



Rating Data Collector - Under the supervision of a certified home energy rater may conduct the inspections necessary to produce a home energy rating

Certified Rater – Covered by current rating standards

Senior Certified Rater - Increased experience and knowledge base to interpret the findings of a rating and make recommendations on how the rating can be improved

Building Performance Specialist - Experience and knowledge to diagnose building performance problems and prescribe solutions

Rating Data Collector Minimum Qualifications

- The ability to identify and quantify various building components and systems
- Able to conduct plans evaluations and takeoffs from plans
- Completion of rating data collector training by a RESNET accredited rater training provider (this would not be the full traditional rater training course but a shorter training session
- Passing the rating data collector national test

Rating Data Collector Minimum Qualifications

- The ability to identify and quantify various building components and systems

- Completion of rating data collector training by a RESNET accredited rater training provider (this would not be the full traditional rater training course but a shorter training session
- Passing the rating data collector national test administered by RESNET

Senior Certified Rater Qualifications

- Experience of being a certified rater for a period of at least one year
- Documented accurately completed ratings and performance tests on a minimum of 35 homes
- Successful completion of a minimum of two optional rater specialist designations
- The ability to perform a complete rating without the use of any reference materials before a rater trainer or quality assurance designee
- Passing the senior rater national test administered by RESNET without the use of any reference material
