Same Construction Type
Typical to the Two Climate Zones

- Pass Seven Consecutive Homes
- Same Set of Trade Contractors





Same Set of Trade Contractors... Trades That Affect Energy Performance

- Insulators
- Air Conditioning Contractors





Exception Request Beyond One-time Exception:

- FACT: In major Texas markets the majority of trades have participated for 5 years.
- FACT: These trades have proven track record.





Request for Exemption Based On:

- Providers Experience with Trades
- Builders Performance
- Trade track record
- Trade on-going training





Request for Exemption from this requirement for Texas trades with documented experience and recommendation from rater/provider.





603.1.3 Analysis of Homes

- Worst Case Options and All Known Packages
- Change in Design Requires Individual Rating
 - BOYL (Build on Your Lot)

- Subdivision
- Metropolitan Area
- Climate Zone

603.1.6 Sampling Controls

 A collection or set of required tests and inspections performed for a sample set of homes.





603.1.6 Sampling Controls

- One in Seven
 - Group of Homes that are Tested and Inspected at Different Stages
 - Pre-sheetrock 100% ONLY
 - Duct Tests (Rough/Final)*
 - Blower Door





Exceed Minimum Requirements

- Homes Batched Daily As They Are Requested
- City Wide
- One Fails Next 6 Are Automatically Tested





603.1.6.9 Builders Must Begin Again...

Exception Request:

- FACT: Protocol Exceeded from the Beginning
- FACT: Builder Agrees to Higher Level of Penalty
- FACT: More Batches Fail Daily Affecting Subdivisions Across the City
 - Request: Grandfathered Builders do not have to start over.





603.1.6.9 Builders Must Begin Again...

Exception Request:

Grandfathered Builders do not have to start over.





603.1.7 Quality Assurance Deal Killer

Rater must test 1 in 7





603.1.7 Quality Assurance Deal Killer Alternative

- Data Collectors
- Supervised by Raters
- Q/A by a Senior Data Analyst
- Q/A by an Executive Operations Manager





603.1.7 Quality Assurance Deal Killer

Exception Request for Process in Place

- Training in Place
- Higher Level of Sampling Penalty
- 100% Pre-sheetrock Inspection Required
- Costly Q/A Makes Sampling Outrageously Expensive
- Complying with Q/A Required by RESNET
- Conclusion Q/A Kills Sampling

New EPA Guidelines:

- Set Minimum Standards at 4 or 6 CFM/100 Sq.Ft. to Outdoors
- Current Defaults at 10% CFM 25 Leakage to the Outdoors
- Current Performance Averages 6%
